The exhibition will be shown from the 23rd of June to the 23rd of September 2012 (TBC), and will then travel to Velvet da Vinci, in San Francisco in the Fall 2012: please make sure that you are happy for your work to be traveling for a minimum of 6 months before deciding to take part.

The exhibition will be accompanied by a catalogue, to be launched at the first opening. In Cagnes, the work of each exhibitor will be shown in individual showcases; you are free to fill (or not fill) this volume as you see fit, with as many pieces as you deem relevant (the showcases come in a variety of formats they average 40 x 40 x 30 cm, are either black or white, and always top-lit). A vaulted crypt, below the galleries, can also be used to show photographic and paper-based installations.
